- Attend meetings with the Head of House, House Captains and house members.
- Lead a team of House Prefects
- Lead promotional activities for the College and the consortium including assemblies, sporting and charity events.

How will students be selected?

- Assembly promoting roles given on 28th April with Job descriptions published on the Kingsmead website for students.
- Students are invited to make an application, in writing, detailing their personal skills and attributes, activities and/or roles and responsibilities they have inside and/or outside College and why they believe they would be suited to the role. Applications must be submitted to Mrs Mist/Mrs Ryder by **Thurs 5th May**
- Applications list published to staff and recommendations requested in support of students.
- Students interviewed using a common set of questions
- Students selected using interview outcomes and staff recommendations before
