

## **Health and Social Care – OCR National Level 2**

### **2 Option blocks**

There are 6 units of work which make up this course.

The Certificate is awarded at Pass, Merit or Distinction, which is equivalent to 4 GCSE grades at C, B or A.

### **1 Option block**

There are 3 units of work which make up this course.

The Certificate is awarded at Pass, Merit or Distinction, which is equivalent to 2 GCSE grades at C, B or A.

### **Outline of course**

The core units involve studying various approaches to working effectively with people to provide quality care, whilst the optional units include some more “hands-on” aspects including First Aid.

### **Coursework requirements**

This course is assessed completely by coursework – there are no exams. Students will have at least one current piece of coursework at any time. All coursework must be completed in school under controlled conditions and can not be completed at home.

### **How parents can help at home**

Talk to students about their work and share your experiences with them.

Encourage them to watch relevant documentary television programmes about health and social issues.

Encourage regular attendance and avoid holidays during term time.
